The competition will be divided into three age groups (ages as at 1 June 2009)

Group **A**: those aged up to and including **8**; each entry to consist of **4 pages**.

Group **B**: those aged from **9** and up to and including **12**; each entry to consist of **8 pages**

Group **C**: those aged from 13 and up to and including **18**; each entry to consist of **16 pages**.

The entries must be on standard album pages, or similar sized paper, including A4, and should be arranged in a portrait (vertical) format and protected in plastic pockets.

There will be prizes in each age group.
